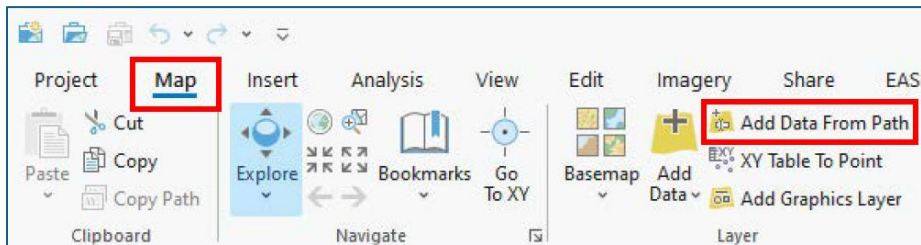


Are you using the most up-to-date RIM boundary GIS shapefiles?

RIM easement boundary GIS data for recorded easements is now available to view in ArcPro/ArcMap as a Web Service Layer. Linking to this data will ensure SWCDs are using the most recent and up-to-date RIM boundary shapefiles when performing site inspections, submitting adjacent RIM applications, and posting boundaries in the field. This is the same boundary data that can be viewed on the [Interactive Web Map](#).

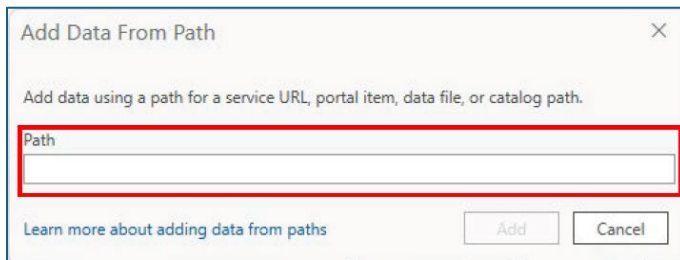
Instructions for adding the “State Funded Conservation Easements (RIM Reserve)” Web Service layer in ArcGIS Pro:

1. Open ArcGIS Pro
2. Select the ‘Map’ tab on the Ribbon, then select ‘Add Data From Path’



3. Copy and paste the following Path into the pop-up window:

4. After the Path has been pasted into the pop-up window, the ‘Service type’ dropdown will appear. It should default to ‘An ArcGIS Server Web Service’ but if not, change the selection in the drop down. Then hit ‘Add’.
5. All recorded RIM Conservation Easements should appear. Newly recorded easements are added to the layer on a monthly basis. However, if BWSR staff make a correction to an existing boundary, the change will appear in this layer the following day.

NOTE: This layer is Read-only. Users who require the use of higher-level analytical tools or wish to manipulate the data should download the dataset from the [Minnesota Geospatial Commons](#), which is updated less frequently.
